## **Checklist for When to Consider Switching/Augmenting Antidepressants**

•	Consider augmentation/combination/dose increase over switching
	when:
	There has been a partial response to the current antidepressant
	The current antidepressant is well-tolerated
	There is a wish to avoid withdrawal symptoms
	There is a desire to target side-effects of current antidepressant
	with an adjunctive agent
	Patient preference
•	Consider switching over augmentation/combination/dose increase when:
	There is no response to the current antidepressant
	There is a desire to simplify the pharmacologic regimen (cost, compliance)
	There is a desire to avoid drug-drug interactions
	Patient preference
