Dr. Greenberg is a full-time Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrician practicing in Savannah, Georgia. She cares for ADHD and developmental disabilities through the lifespan. She is an Associate Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Mercer University School of Medicine, teaching medical students, pediatric residents and family practice residents. She is an attending Pediatrician at Memorial University Medical Center Children's Hospital in Savannah. She was trained at Cornell U. School of Arts and Sciences, receiving her BA, and she received her MD degree at Albany Medical College, interned in Pediatrics at Boston City Hospital, and did her Pediatric Residency at Mass. General Hospital, receiving a Bunting Fellowship simultaneously, from Radcliffe College. She was a Developmental Pediatrics fellow with Dr. Hilda Knobloch, at Albany Medical College, and she has practiced Developmental Pediatrics for 44 of her 50 years of practicing medicine. During this time, she has been a returning lecturer for national courses with the AAP Pediatric PREP, in their DB PREP, and AAP Practical Pediatrics course. She teaches Osler Pediatric and Family Practice Board Review Courses, Hackensack Medical Center yearly course in D and B Pediatrics, and the US Psychiatric and Mental Health Congress where she has lectured for the past six years. She has recently returned from lecturing at the 3rd annual International Psychiatry Symposium in Doha, Qatar, and she has lectured in Jamaica and Recife, Brazil twice. She specializes in ADHD through the lifespan, and she lectures on this topic as well as Autism Spectrum Disorders, Tourette Syndrome, Bullying, Behavioral Phenotypes of Fragile X and Down Syndrome, Children of Divorce, as well as the effects of deployment on children of the military. She is married to pediatrician and medical ethicist, Dr. Martin Greenberg, and she is the mother of Michael and Sarah, and the grandmother of Sam, Ben, Hannah and Alex.
