Joseph R. Calabrese, M.D. is the recipient of the Bipolar Disorders Research Chair, the Director the Bipolar Disorders Research Center, and the Director of the Mood Disorders Program at Case Western Reserve University. He has directed or co-directed three separate research centers that were dedicated to improving clinical outcomes in under-served populations of bipolar disorder, including those with bipolar depression, rapid cycling, children and adolescents, adults with substance use disorders as well as members of the Reserve Component of the US Department of Defence. Dr. Calabrese has received five lifetime achievement awards, including the "The Nola Maddox Falcone Prize for Affective Disorders" in 2005 (NARSAD), the Gerald L. Klerman Lifetime Achievement Award in 2008, and the 2013 Lifetime Achievement Award from the European Bipolar Forum. His H index is 85.
