

Carol H. Wysham, MD

Dr. Carol Hatch Wysham is Clinical Professor of Medicine at the University of Washington School of Medicine and is the Section Head of The Rockwood Center for Diabetes and Endocrinology at Rockwood Clinic in Spokane, WA. She obtained her M.D. from the University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine, completed Residency in Internal Medicine at Oregon Health Sciences University, and a Fellowship in Endocrinology and Metabolism from the University of Iowa Hospitals/Clinic, Iowa City, USA. She has served as the Chair of the Professional Practice Committee of the ADA (2011, 2012), as co-chair

of the ICE/ENDO 2014 and ENDO 2015 Annual Meetings, and Overall Chair of ENDO 2016. She is the recipient of the O.C. Olson Lectureship award (1996), and the Rockwood Clinic Chairman's Quality Award (2011, 2015).

Dr. Wysham has been involved in clinical research throughout her career. She has served as the principal investigator for several large-scale clinical trials related to diabetes and its complications/treatments. These include the ACCORD trial, the AIM-HIGH trial, the ADOPT trial, FLAT-SUGAR, as well as several of the long-term cardiovascular outcome trials, including: Sitagliptin (TECOS), Empagliflozin (EMPA-REG), Liraglutide (LEADER), and Canagliflozin (CANVAS). She has authored numerous publications in peer-reviewed journals that include Lancet, Diabetes Care, Mayo Clinic Proceedings, Endocrine Practice, Diabetes Obesity and Metabolism and Diabetes Medicine
