

Steven Nathan, MD is the Director of the Advanced Lung Disease Program and Medical Director of the Lung Transplant Program at Inova Fairfax Hospital in Falls Church, VA. He is Professor of Medicine at Virginia Commonwealth University, Inova Fairfax Campus. Dr. Nathan received his medical degree at the University of the Witwatersrand Medical School in Johannesburg, South Africa, and he completed his internship in internal medicine and general surgery at the Johannesburg Hospital. Dr. Nathan performed his internal medicine residency at Long Island Jewish Hospital in New York City, and completed his fellowships in pulmonary medicine, critical care, and lung

transplantation at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, CA. He is board-certified in internal medicine, pulmonary diseases, and critical care medicine.

Dr. Nathan has authored more than 380 publications, including original research manuscripts, abstracts, reviews, and book chapters. He has also co-edited and authored two books on IPF. Dr. Nathan is a reviewer for multiple journals and is on the editorial board for the journal, *Thorax*. He has served on multiple committees, including the US Food and Drug Administration advisory boards, as well as steering committees for clinical trials in IPF and pulmonary hypertension, where he has also served as Chair. Dr. Nathan is a member of several professional medical associations, including the American Thoracic Society, the American College of Chest Physicians, and the International Society for Heart and Lung Transplantation. He has delivered talks and been Chairperson of numerous sessions at many national and international conferences.
