Russell D. Cohen, MD, FACG, AGAF, is a Professor of Medicine in the Department of Medicine, Section of Gastroenterology at the University of Chicago in Illinois. In addition, he is Director of the Inflammatory Bowel Disease Center and Co-director of the Advanced IBD Fellowship Program at the University of Chicago.

Dr Cohen earned his bachelor of science degree in biological sciences at Cornell University in Ithaca, New York, and his medical degree with honors at Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City. He completed his internship and residency in internal medicine at Harvard's Beth Israel Hospital, and his fellowship in gastroenterology and nutrition and inflammatory bowel disease at the University of Chicago.

Dr Cohen has been Principal Investigator or Co-investigator for more than 50 research projects in his field, has edited 2 medical textbooks, and has authored or coauthored more than 150 articles, abstracts, reviews, books, book chapters, and audiotapes primarily devoted to Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis.
