Brian Hujdich serves as Executive Director of HealthHIV, one of the largest national HIV nonprofit organizations, which has expanded its scope and reach to also address hepatitis C virus (HCV) and LGBT health. Mr. Hujdich has over 31 years of experience in healthcare nonprofit management, medical advertising, healthcare public relations, public policy, capacity building, training, and medical education.

At HealthHIV, Mr. Hujdich oversees a diverse portfolio of programs and initiatives, which sync to advance community health and support the integration of HIV into primary care, including national training and capacity building programs reaching HIV and HCV care providers, LGBT providers, health centers, health departments, administrators, medical educators, community-based organizations, and consumers. HealthHIV also leads a HealthHCV initiative, the National Coalition for LGBT Health, and the Pozitively Healthy HIV consumer coalition.

Prior to leading HealthHIV, Mr. Hujdich served first as Vice President and then Interim Executive Director of the American Academy of HIV Medicine. In addition, he was Account Director of Medicus (Publicis), where he supervised consumer and professional advertising and medical education for numerous HIV treatments and diagnostics. Mr. Hujdich also worked in healthcare practice at several major public relations firms where he managed numerous HIV product introductions and worked with a variety of HIV/AIDS service organizations, AIDS community-based organizations, and nonprofit agencies.
