Jeffrey T. Kirchner, DO, FAAFP, AAHIVS, is Medical Director of LGHP-Comprehensive Care at Lancaster General Hospital (LGH). The practice is a Ryan White–funded site that serves adults with HIV /AIDS in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, city and county. It is 1 of 4 academic practices affiliated with the Family Medicine Residency program at LGH and serves as a training site for residents and medical students.

Dr. Kirchner is a 1985 graduate of the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. He completed his family medicine residency at Abington Memorial Hospital, where he served as chief resident. After residency, he worked for the Health Care for the Homeless Project in Washington, DC. He was in a private group practice in Lancaster from 1990 through 1996 and joined the LGH residency faculty in September 1996. His primary medical interests include HIV/AIDS, addiction medicine, writing, and medical publications. He is a former associate editor of *American Family Physician* and serves on the editorial board of the *Journal of Family Practice*. He is the medical editor of *HIV Specialist* magazine for the American Academy of HIV Medicine and serves on their national board. He is board-certified in family medicine by the American Board of Family Medicine and as an HIV specialist by the American Academy of HIV Medicine.
