John M. Kane, MD, is vice president for Behavioral Health Services of Northwell Health and chairman of psychiatry at The Zucker Hillside Hospital. He is chairman of psychiatry and professor of psychiatry and molecular medicine at the Hofstra Northwell School of Medicine. Dr. Kane received his BA from Cornell University and his MD from the New York University School of Medicine.

He currently directs the NIMH-funded Advanced Center for Interventions and Services Research in Schizophrenia at The Zucker Hillside Hospital. He has been a member of the Board of Scientific Counselors for NIMH, and he has served on the council of the American College of Neuropsychopharmacology.
