



Dr. Lianne Gensler is a rheumatologist at University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) Medical Center and director of the Ankylosing Spondylitis Clinic. She is also an associate professor of medicine at UCSF School of Medicine.

Dr. Gensler earned her medical degree at the University of California, Irvine. She completed an internal medicine residency, chief residency, and rheumatology fellowship at UCSF and then joined the medical staff in Rheumatology.

Her primary research interests are the disease progression, outcomes, and biomarkers of ankylosing spondylitis and axial spondyloarthritis, and the predictors of osteoporosis development in patients with systemic lupus erythematosus. Dr. Gensler is one of the

authors of the American College of Rheumatology/Spondylitis Association of America/Spondyloarthritis Research and Treatment Network 2015 Recommendations for the Treatment of Ankylosing Spondylitis and Nonradiographic Axial Spondyloarthritis. She has been honored with the Ira M. Goldstein Teaching Award in Rheumatology, the Spondylitis Association Young Investigator Award, and the UCSF Research Mentoring Award.
