Armstrong, MD, MPH, is Associate Dean for Clinical Research, Associate Professor of Dermatology, Director of Clinical Research at the Clinical and Translational Science Institute, Director of Clinical Trials and Outcomes Research, and Director of the Psoriasis Program in the Department of Dermatology at the Keck School of Medicine of USC in Los Angeles, California. Dr. Armstrong earned her medical degree at Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. She completed an internship in Internal Medicine at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, followed by a residency in Dermatology through the Harvard Combined Dermatology Residency Training Program. She completed a Clinical Effectiveness Program and earned her Master of Public Health degree at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health. Dr. Armstrong is board-certified in Dermatology.

Dr. Armstrong is a member of the American Academy of Dermatology, the Society for Investigative Dermatology, and the Group for Research and Assessment of Psoriasis and Psoriatic Arthritis. Her research experience has focused on patients with moderate to severe plaque psoriasis, psoriatic arthritis, and vascular inflammation from psoriasis. She is on the editorial board for *JAMA Dermatology* and the *Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology*. She has written articles that have been published in the *Journal of Dermatological Treatment*, the *Journal of Cutaneous Pathology*, and *The Journal of Rheumatology*. Dr. Armstrong has been a frequently invited presenter for the National Psoriasis Foundation and the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology.
