Leonard H. Calabrese, DO, is Professor of Medicine at the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine of Case Western Reserve University and Vice Chair of the Department of Rheumatic and Immunologic Diseases. Dr. Calabrese is the Director of the RJ Fasenmyer Center for Clinical Immunology at the Cleveland Clinic specializing in diseases of the immune system, including autoimmunity diseases and primary and secondary immunodeficiency disorders. Dr. Calabrese has extensively published on the safety of biologic therapies for autoimmune diseases including the epidemiology of opportunistic and viral infections. Dr. Calabrese is the Co-director of the Center for Vasculitis Care and Research and holds a joint appointment in the Department of Infectious Diseases.

Dr. Calabrese also has a clinical and research interest in wellness and in particular how behavior and personal choice can influence the integrity of the immune response and immunologic diseases.

Dr. Calabrese has lectured nationally and internationally on the subjects of clinical immunology, rheumatology and virology and is the author of over 400 published peer reviewed articles, book chapters and reviews.
