



Julian Schink, MD, Chief, Division of Gynecological Oncology, Cancer Treatment Centers of America

Dr. Schink completed a four-year residency in obstetrics and gynecology at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago, Illinois. He also completed a fellowship in gynecologic oncology at the UCLA Medical School in Los Angeles, California.

Dr. Schink has held numerous academic positions, including vice chair of obstetrics and gynecology and professor at the University of Wisconsin Medical School; an endowed professorship, as the John I Brewer professor of gynecology and cancer research at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine; chief of women's health at Spectrum Health; and professor of obstetrics and gynecology at Michigan State University. Dr. Schink has been published in several medical journals, including over 125 publications in oncology and women's health. He has authored more than 10 chapters in oncology textbooks, particularly focusing on gestational trophoblastic disease. He has also served as principal investigator and co-investigator for many large clinical trials.

Currently, Dr. Schink serves as chief of gynecologic oncology at Cancer Treatment Centers of America and medical director of gynecologic and medical oncology at CTCA in Chicago.
