Peter A Lio, MD is Assistant Professor of Clinical Dermatology and Pediatrics at Northwestern University, Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago, Illinois, and founding director of the Chicago Integrative Eczema Center. He is also a Founding Partner of Medical Dermatology Associates of Chicago. Dr. Lio received his medical degree from Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. He completed an internship at Boston Children’s Hospital and his residency in dermatology at Massachusetts General Hospital for Children, where he served as Chief Resident.

Dr. Lio is a fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology (AAD) and member of the Society for Pediatric Dermatology, Chicago Dermatological Society, and Association of Professors of Dermatology. He is also a Scientific Advisory Board Member for the National Eczema Association and continues to be active in clinical research. His interests include eczema, acne, dermatomyositis, as well as other inflammatory skin diseases, and the integration of alternative and complementary medicines into dermatology; he has spoken nationally and internationally on these topics.

Dr. Lio has written more than 100 articles and textbook chapters. He is an editor for *Color Atlas & Synopsis of Pediatric Dermatology* and the *Handbook of Integrative Dermatology: An Evidence-Based Approach* and section editor for the *Archives of Diseases in Childhood*. Dr. Lio has received numerous awards, including the *Journal of Drugs in Dermatology* Leader of Distinction Award, the AAD Presidential Citation Award, and on multiple occasions the Feinberg School of Medicine Outstanding Teacher Award.
