Dr. O'Gurek earned his medical degree from the Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine, Hershey, and completed a family medicine residency at Lancaster General Health where he served as co-chief resident. He currently serves as interim chair of the Department of Family & Community Medicine at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University; medical director of the TRUST Clinic, an office-based opioid treatment (OBOT) program at Temple Health; and founding director of the Center for Urban Bioethics' Begin the Turn program, a community-based, multidisciplinary mobile care unit serving patients with opioid use disorder and homelessness in North Philadelphia. Notably, he has partnered with the City of Philadelphia and its agencies to address the overdose crisis. He is a former chair of the American Academy of Family Physician's Commission on Health of the Public and Science and former board chair and president of the Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians.
