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Tanya Barauskas Dorff, MD is Professor of Medicine in the Department of Medical Oncology and Therapeutics Research at the City of Hope. She serves as Section Chief of the Genitourinary Cancers Program and Vice Chair of Clinical Affairs. Dr. Dorff is co-chair of the Prostate subcommittee within the SWOG genitourinary cancer committee and is leading efforts surrounding diversity, equity and inclusion for that group. She is also a member of the NCCN guidelines panel for prostate cancer.

In addition to having published over 110 publications and over 50 review articles, Dr. Dorff serves as associate editor for Prostate Cancer Prostatic Diseases and Seminars in Urologic Oncology. Her translational research currently focuses on immunotherapy trials, including combination approaches and novel cellular therapeutics, for prostate cancer as well as targeted therapeutics. She has been invited to speak about her research at multiple national and international meetings.
