Denis Balaban, MD is a neuroimmunologist at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) in Boston, and a member of the MGH Vasculitis Program. He specializes in treating patients with CNS vasculitis, neurosarcoidosis, autoimmune encephalitis, and other neuroinflammatory diseases. His current work focuses on clinical research in neurosarcoidosis myelitis, cauda equina syndrome with intravascular lymphoma, and HIV-related demyelination. He completed his residency at Mass General Brigham, followed by an Advanced General Autoimmune Neurology fellowship at MGH, and the Anne B. Young Translational Neuroscience Fellowship at Biogen and MGH, a joint two-year training program in translational neuroscience.
