Kris V. Kowdley, MD, FACP, FACG, AGAF, FAASLD is Director of Liver Institute Northwest and professor, Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine at Washington State University. He received his B.S. in Biology and Anthropology from Columbia University, and his medical degree from Mount Sinai School of Medicine. He completed his internship and residency at Oregon Health Science University and a Fellowship in Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Tufts University School of Medicine.

Dr. Kowdley is internationally recognized as a clinician, educator, and researcher in liver disease. He has led several major international clinical trials of new treatments for hepatitis C, primary biliary cholangitis, primary sclerosing cholangitis and nonalcoholic steatohepatitis.

Dr. Kowdley is the author of more than 1,000 articles, book chapters, reviews, abstracts and commentaries, and his scholarly work has been cited more than 70,000 times (h-index 123), according to Google Scholar. He is on the Web of Science list of “Highly Cited Researchers” (top 1% by citations for field) for 2019-2023.
